Project: Relocation request

Location: Leicester



Overview

Pickerings were tasked by Leicester City Council to move a temporary modular building from one shcool, accross Leicester to another.

This involved tight access, road closures, parking suspensions, which was all applied by ourselves. We had one day to complete the lift but had been working on the foundations 3 months prior to the move.



Our Solution

Our team ensured that there was minimum disruption to the schools and their neighbours. The first school had very tight access which involved specialist lifting teams, vehicle escorts and movement orders to ensure a smotth transition.

The site at the second school, where the building was transfered to, was originally a pond which we had to drain and liaise with the environmental protections services to ensure a safe removal of all animals. We then laid the foundations at a suitable depth in order to provide all of the services to the new temporary modular building site ahead of its arrival.

Now the unit has been successfully moved to its new home, we are working on refurbing the units to education standards inside and out.
