CO2 Extinguishers are the go-to choice when it comes to fires involving electrical equipment such as in the office, as they won't harm PC's, monitors, or electrical cabling and they leave no residue behind after use.

Standard Water Extinguishers are designed to deal with Class A fires only. They're a

cheaper option that can deal with common fires such as those that have taken hold on wood, paper and textiles.

AFFF Foam Extinguishers are a very effective option for both A and B class fires, which makes them a good option for many different environments.

Dry Powder Extinguishers are another very versatile type, being effective on all but Class F. They're often known as ABC Powder Extinguishers because they're widely used on Class A, B and C.
